School dinners

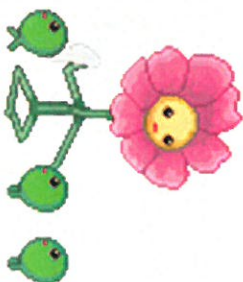
All Reception children are entitled to a free dinner provided by the school.
