Theme – What Would Dr Who do?



Assemblies: Our assembly will be on Friday 19th January everyone is welcome.

Homework:



- Given out Friday due in the following Wednesday.
- Please support you child with learning their spellings and science vocabulary.
- Please continue to use the Homework Support Folder.
- Children having problems should speak to their teacher on Monday and can go to Homework Club on Tuesday and Friday lunchtimes.

Literacy:

- The children will be writing character and setting descriptions using Dr Who and a Science Fiction themed book to help them.

Maths:



- Multiplication and division (Multiplying 3 digits together and looking at factor pairs, dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers).
- We will also be beginning to understand the area of shapes and fractions.
- Application of skills, reasoning and problem solving will also be focused on.
- Please use the school's new calculation policy to support your child.

Topic:

- In our topic lessons we will be going back in time to find out the impact of how the Anglo Saxons changed our lives today.
- In ICT the children will be becoming digital musicians and creating our own music for an episode of Dr Who.
- DT: The children will design and make something out of fabric and textiles.
- In PSHE the children will be learning about safety both personal and environmental safety.
- In Science the children will be studying sound and light and looking at how both work. We will also look at how the eye and the ear work.
- In PE the children will be participating in dance.
