### Theme – ‘Red Sky at Night’

#### Homework:

#### PE:

#### Trips:

We will be going to the ‘Safety Centre’ in Milton Keynes on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2018. We will also be going to Ferry Meadows on July 5<sup>th</sup> as part of our topic.



#### Literacy:

- The children will be creating a travel brochure for a trip around the World. We will then link our Science to our literacy by completing some explanation writing. This will be followed by diary writing and persuasive writing.

#### Maths:

- Negative numbers and linking this to handling data.
- Measurement and conversions from Kilograms to grams, Litres to millilitres and Metres to centimetres to millimetres.
- Time and money conversions.
- Properties of shape. Position and movement.
- Area and perimeter.
- Proportion and Ratio.



#### Reading:

- We will be continuing to read a book called ‘Storm Breaker’ by Anthony Horowitz. During our Destination Reader lessons we will be looking at a variety of non- fiction, fiction and poetry texts to give the children a varied experience of language and understanding.
- Please listen to your child read regularly. They should be reading at least 5 times a week. Please sign their Reading Records.

#### Topic:

- In our topic lessons we will have a geographical focus and be travelling around the UK and then the world, gaining an understanding of it and writing about it.
- In computing the children will be looking at the weather and how it is recorded using Excel. They will be creating graphs and looking and analysing data.
- In DT the children will design and make something out of fabric and textiles.
- In PSHE the children will be learning about safety both personal and environmental.
- In science the children will be studying states of matter and looking at the water cycle.
- In PE the children will be participating in invasion games and Athletics.
- In MFL the children will be learning about pets, animals, and telling the time in French.
